## About the Vishwavidyalaya

Doctor Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya Sagar (A Central University), formerly University of Saugor, was established on 18<sup>th</sup> July 1946 by Dr. Sir Hari Singh Gour, a great jurist, educationist, social reformer and legal luminary. This 18<sup>th</sup> University of India and the oldest and the biggest University of Madhya Pradesh has perhaps the singular distinction of being founded by the munificence of a single person's hard earned money of about two crore of rupees. The University was rechristened as Doctor Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya in February 1983 by the State Legislature. The University is situated 5 Km. east of Sagar city and campus covers an area of 1312.89 acres over Pathatiya Hills connected to the Vindhya Range, surrounded by lush green forests. It has 36 University teaching departments (number keeps adding) 11 schools with 37 affiliated colleges.

## School of Education

School of Education (SoE), Doctor Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar came into existence initially as Post Graduate Basic Training (PGBT) College of the Madhya Pradesh government in 1961. It was a famous Teachers Training Institute in the Sagar district of Madhya Pradesh running B.Ed., M.Ed. and Diploma training programmes. Further, state government handed over this college by its letter no. Trgk/67/2053 dated 19 June 1967 to University of Saugor with all its physical and human resources and it was renamed as 'University College of Education'. After the up-gradation of the university as a Central University in 2009, this University College of Education with all its entities and amenities was transformed into a Department of Education on 27 March, 2011. Further, in December, 2015 Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India upgraded this department into School of Education with its two centres namely Centre for Pre-service Teacher Education (CPSTE) and Centre for Professional Development of Teacher Educators (CPDTE).

## About the Workshop

Academic writing is an integral part of research and generation of scientific knowledge. It is different from other kinds of writing and needs a different kind of task flow and follows a logic that is quite different from more general-audience writing. It has been observed that the research scholars of social sciences in preparing research proposal, report writing faces difficulty. This workshop aims to fill the gap by

providing the fundamental knowledge required for effective and result oriented academic writing. The workshop will consist of lectures and interactive sessions aimed at strengthening the scholars' perspectives on contemporary academic writing. The workshop targets enrolled scholars of Ph.D. (Social Sciences) who have conducted research and need to develop their scientific writing skills.

## Objectives of the Workshop

The workshop will discuss the various aspects of academic writing including, how to write proposal/ reports in social sciences. Followings are the main objectives of workshop:

- To gain insight into research ethics.
- To enable participants for formulating research problem, research question, objectives, and methodology including finding and conclusion.
- Equipping participants for preparing model synopsis in social science researches.
- Learning to write effective thesis in social science researches.
- Suggesting participants to write scholarly research paper for publication.
